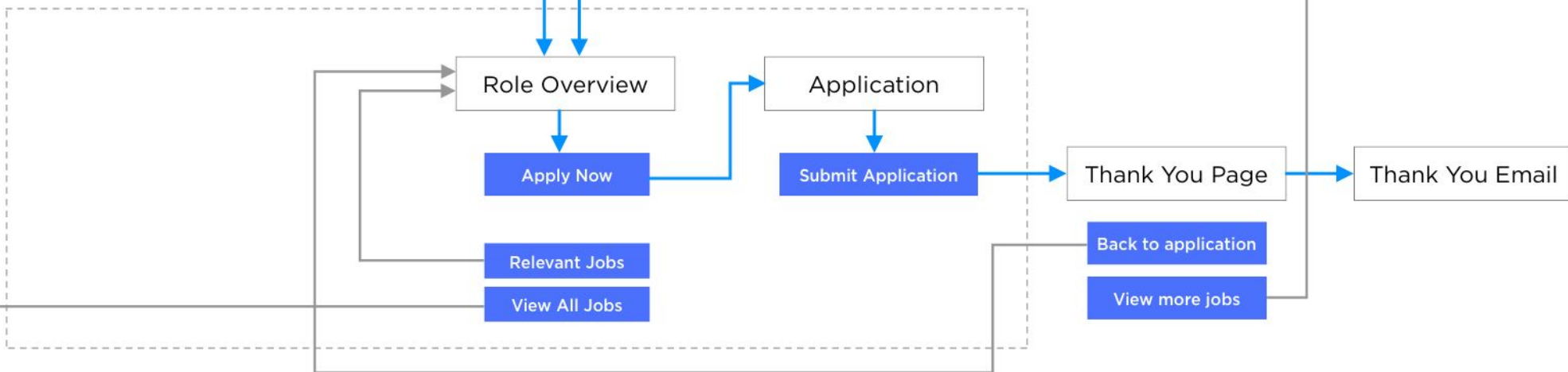
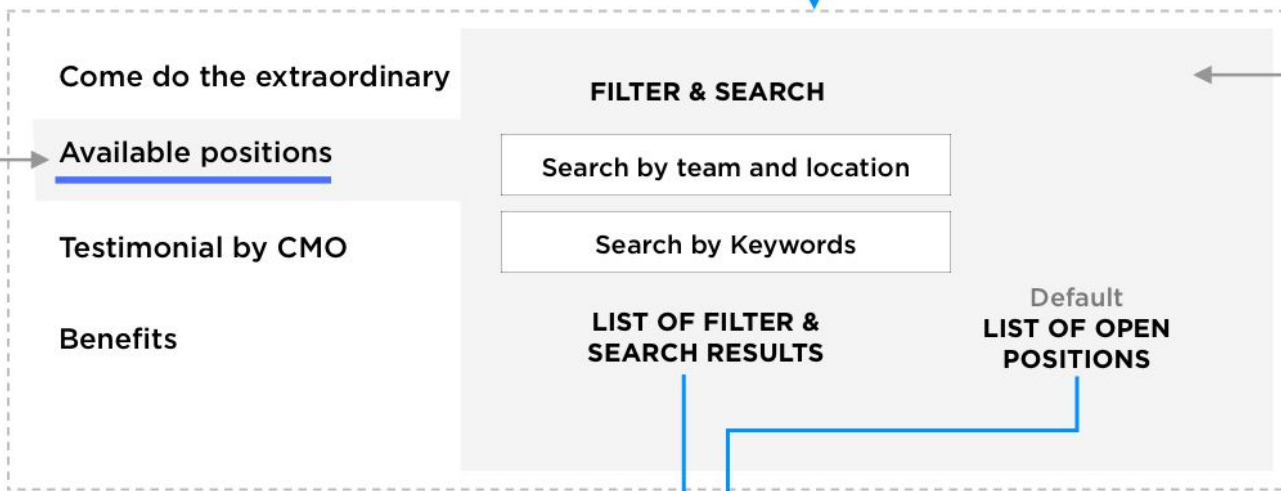
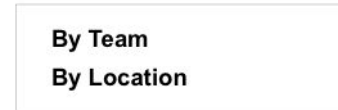

Text as "No current openings."

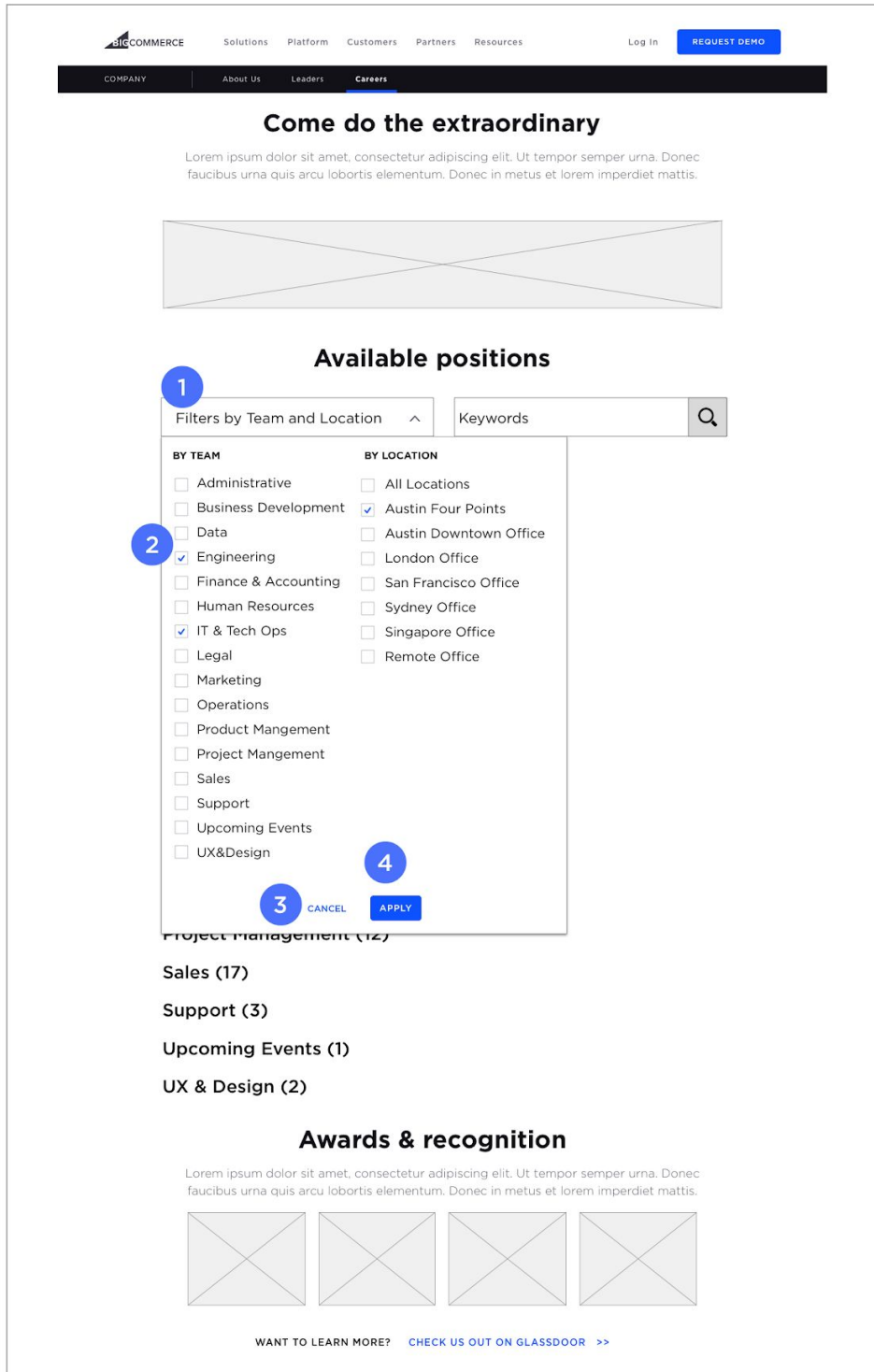
6. CTA for External URL

1. Drop-down Filter:

Click the expander and the dropdown menu will expand. It contains the team and the location.

2. Check Box:

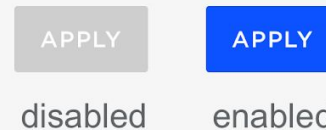
Default is unselected. Users can select as much as they want. When users ckeck the box, the screen will be updated based on selections.

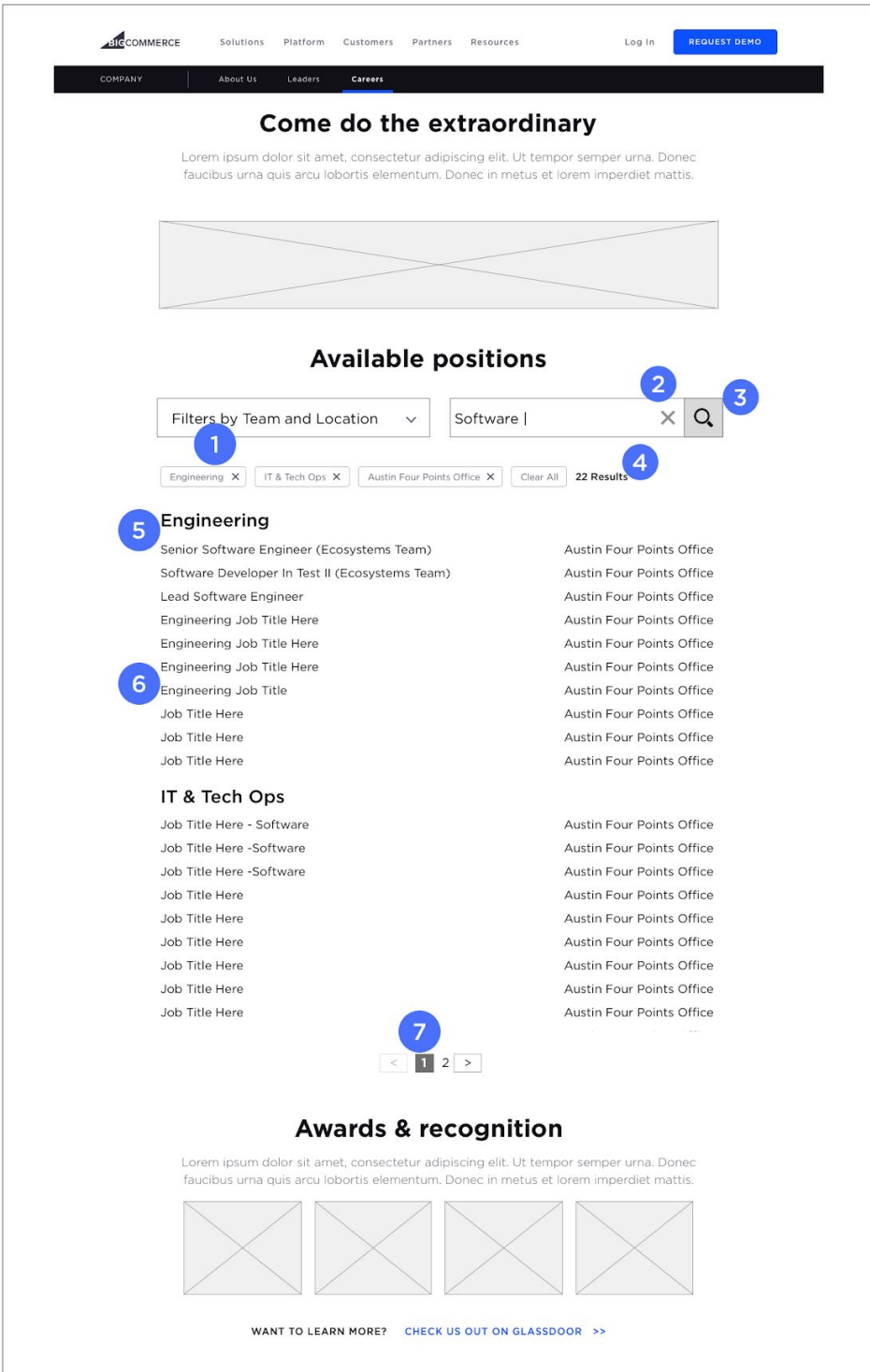
3. Cancel CTA:

When click the cancel button, the dropdown menu will be collapsed and the selection doesn't apply.

4. Apply CTA:

Default is the disabled state. When users select the check box it will go to enabled state.





1. Filter Results:

Users can close out the results by using the “x” icon. The screen will be updated.

2. Clear All button:

It will delete all filter results and go back to default screen.

3. Search button:

When a button is clicked, users can see the results.

4. Total number of results:

Display a job posting number.

5. Team Title:

Display team result.

6. Opening job lists:

Display job search results. Maximum display lists are 20. If job number exceeds more than 20, it goes to the next page. Order list by alphabetically.

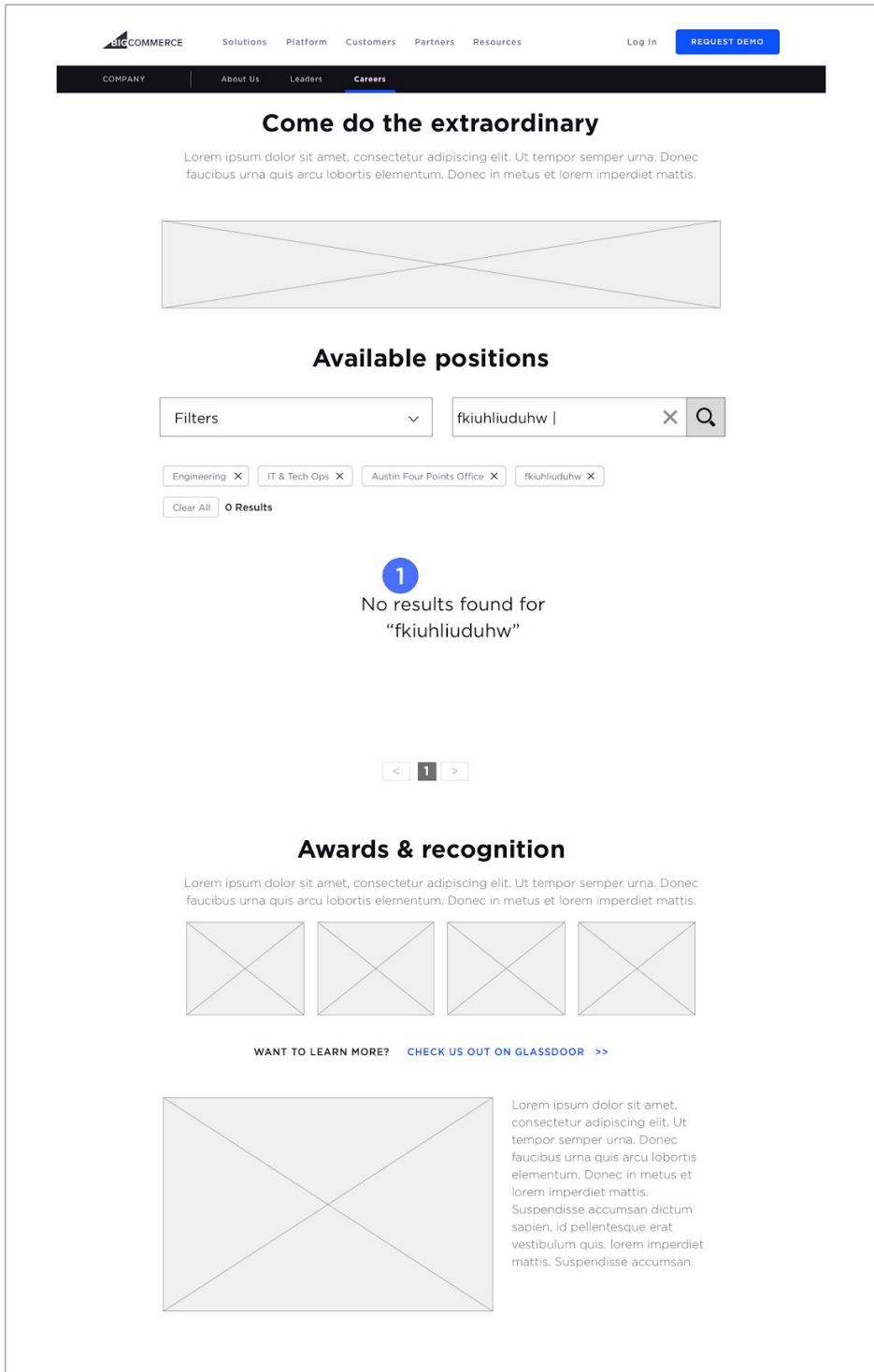
7. Pagination:
